OSHA 30-Hour is the week of February 3rd and all 4 days MUST be attended in order to receive your certificate/card.

\*Silica Awareness/Fit Testing –

Due to the known respiratory hazards of silica in the construction industry, Local 404 JATC will be conducting Silica Awareness and Training for the members of Local 404.

If you plan on being fitted for a respirator as part of the Silica Awareness Class please be advised that there are requirements that have to be completed prior to attending the class on February 7th, February 14<sup>th</sup> or February 17<sup>th</sup>. See checklist below –

1. You must be clean shaven to be fit tested, this means no facial hair.  
(No sideburns, goatees or mustaches)
2. You must have a current drug card and be a member in good standing.
3. A medical Questionnaire must be completed and submitted to Mobile Medical one month prior to the fit testing. The medical questionnaire is available online at [www.mobmed.com](http://www.mobmed.com) under the MARS Program section. This questionnaire can be submitted at the same site.
4. Once medical questionnaire is approved a pulmonary function test must be completed. Pulmonary function test may be scheduled at Mobile Medical's office or at Local 404 the day of the fit test.

Once these 4 requirements have been met, you will be able to be fit tested. Please bring the respirator you plan on wearing on a daily basis to the fit test.

Construction Field Software will cover Procore this year. At the end of the 2-day class, a Certification of Completion will be issued thru Procore. Both days must be attended in order to receive the certification.

Introduction to Total Stations is a basic intro to the software and equipment associated with a Robotic Total Station. This 2-day class is a requirement for further training to be presented to the members this summer. Dates to be announced.
